Julius, Simon, Timothy and Njoroge will be in grade 8.





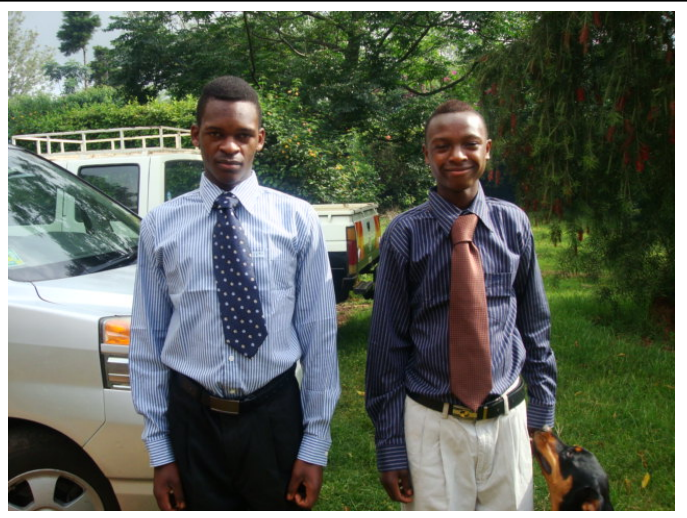

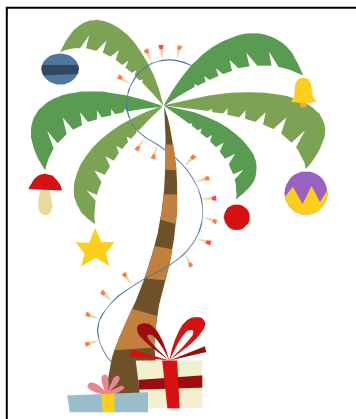
Kennedy and Kariuki in grade 6.,

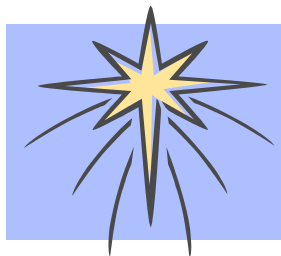
